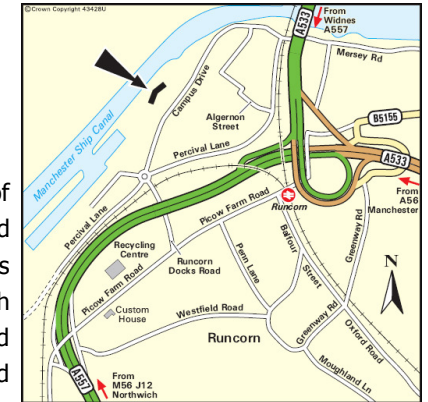
Runcorn Linnets Return Home

Our Aims

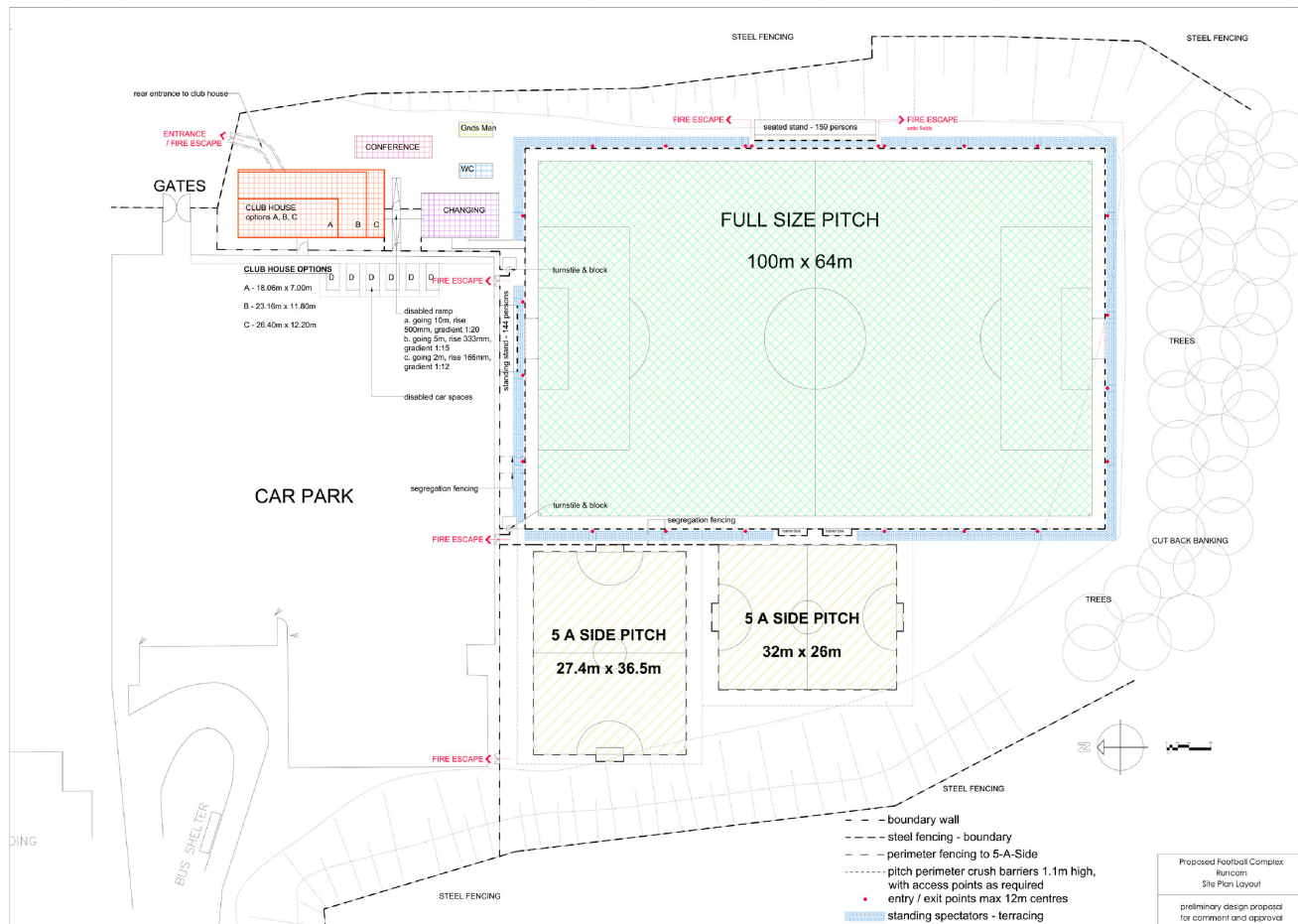
- To preserve 90 years of top-class non-league football in Runcorn

The location of the proposed new ground is ideal, with excellent road and rail links and right at the heart of the local community. The proposed lease deal with the college will allow for College use of the facilities. We have established links with local junior football and ladies football within the town and the all weather facilities will allow multi sport use.

We have worked closely with one of our main sponsors, GMS, to draw up our planned proposals for the facility. This would consist of a ground of UniBond League standard, together with a Community Centre. We also wish to integrate 2 all-weather pitches on the site for use by local sporting organisations or groups.
